Melan(o)-	Black color	Melanin
Melos	Extremity	Erthromelalgia
Mero-	Part	Merocrine, meroblastic
Mes(o)-	Middle	Mesoderm
Meta-	After, beyond or change	Metacarpus
Myri-	Ten thousand	Myriad
Myx(o)-	Mucus	Myxoma
Narc(o)-	Numb, sleep	Narcolepsy
Om(o)-	Shoulder	Omostrate
Omphal(o)-	Of or pertaining to the navel, the umbilicus	Omphalotomy
Optic(o)-	of or relating to chemical properties of the eye	Opticochemical
Ossi-	Bone	Peripheral ossifying fibroma
Pan-, pant(o)-	Denoting something as 'complete' or containing 'everything'	Panophobia, panopticon
